State Police Investigate Drowning at Bottomless Lake State Park

Roswell—Two boys were swimming in Lea Lake at the Bottomless Lake State Park when one, 15 year old Iram Bustos, started to have trouble in the water. The other, 17 year old Jesus Alan Luna-Olivares, swam to help him. Both went under the water.

Iram was brought out while Jesus Alan Luna-Olivares was still underneath the water and was not located for approximately five minutes. Lifeguards at the scene as well as an unidentified individual assisted in administering aid to them.

Once they were taken from the water both were transported to Eastern New Mexico Medical Center in Roswell. Iram is in stable condition.

Jesus Alan Luna-Olivares was pronounced deceased at 7:21 P.M. at Eastern New Mexico Medical Center. He is from Juarez, Mexico and is the cousin of Iram Bustos who lives in San Patricio, New Mexico.

The State Police were called at about 2:00 pm Sunday June 8th and is continuing to investigate this incident.
