### **Three Ejected on Single Vehicle Crash**

Lindrith – State Police were alerted to a single vehicle rollover this afternoon in Rio Arriba County.

Upon the State Police officers arrival they quickly learned that three of the four were ejected, and three life guard helicopters were needed. The investigation showed that 36 y.o. Andrea T. Cisneros of Espanola was driving on State Road 595 near mile post 9 in a 2001 Land Rover. Andrea T. Cisneros lost control of her vehicle after she drove off the roadway, overcorrected and subsequently rolled. The passengers 16 y.o. Christina Cisneros, 17 y.o. Phillip Cisneros and a small child were ejected. The driver once extricated, and the passengers were transported to Farmington, Espanola, Santa Fe and Albuquerque hospitals.

Alcohol is a contributing factor in the crash. The two teens that were ejected were not wearing their seatbelts.
