Single Vehicle Roll-Over kills Carlsbad Resident

Carlsbad – 23 y.o. Glen A. Hedgecock of Carlsbad, NM died Tuesday afternoon from a late Monday motor vehicle crash.

State Police officers from the Carlsbad office responded to a single vehicle crash just after 9:30 PM Monday evening north of Carlsbad on Eddy County Road 206. Upon the officers' arrival they learned that Glen A Hedgecock was traveling at a high rate of speed north bound on CR 206 in his 2002 Nissan car. Hedgecock struck a cow that was standing in the roadway and went into a counter clockwise slide off the roadway, into a single roll over. Hedgecock sustained critical injuries and was transported to Artesia General Hospital, due to the severity of the injuries, Hedgecock was airlifted to Lubbock Medical Center in Lubbock, Texas.

Yesterday afternoon Mr. Hedgecock died as a result of the critical injuries. Speed was considered a contributing factor in the crash as well as the livestock on the roadway, Alcohol and seat belts were not contributing factors.
