### **Two Vehicle Collision Kills One and Leaves Two in a Coma**

Farmington — Norman Jordon of La Jara, New Mexico, died Friday afternoon in a two vehicle collision outside Farmington.

State Police Officers were called to a two vehicle collision just before 1:00 PM Friday afternoon, upon the officers arrival they learned that 32 y.o. Melisendro Lovato of La Jara, and passenger were traveling south on US 550 near mile post 103 in a 07 Dodge pick-up, when 24 y.o. Razahn Lamone of Ojo Encino drove onto US 550 without yielding right of way.

The 2000 Ford Mustang was struck in a t-bone manner by the pick-up throwing the mustangs right rear seat passenger 45 y.o. Norman Jordon from the vehicle, coming to rest on the roadway, where he was pronounced deceased. Razahn Lamone and the left rear seat passenger Darrel Joe remain in a coma at San Juan Regional Medical center. Melisendro Lovato and passenger were treated and released as well as the right front seat passenger of the Mustang 29 y.o. Jerome Herrera.

Officers learned that Razahn Lamone and passengers were on a beer run and had already been consuming alcohol that morning. Failing to wear seatbelts, failing to yield right away and alcohol are being listed as contributing factors in the crash.
