San Juan County Officials Make Arrest on Domestic Dispute

Farmington — State Police will determine the employment status of a Farmington assigned State Police officer by the week's end.

Just before 4:00 AM this morning, San Juan County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to a residence for a disturbance call. Upon the deputies' arrival, they learned that off-duty State Police officer Luis Serrano, 28, of Farmington, NM and his wife Andrea Serrano were involved in a domestic dispute at their friend's residence. Through their investigation, San Juan County Sheriff's Department determined there was enough evidence to charge Serrano with Battery on a Household Member. The case has since been referred to the San Juan County District Attorney's office for review.

Serrano has been placed on paid administrative leave stemming from this incident, and his employment status will be determined by the Office of the Chief, by the end of the week. Serrano has been employed with the New Mexico State Police in the uniform bureau since February 8th, 2009.
